

“Deercc” – The Love of God Céile Dé Residential Teaching Retreat with Fionntulach

This residential retreat is an opportunity to explore and absorb the transformational teachings of the Céile Dé and to enter deeply into this ancient, esoteric Celtic spiritual tradition.

To help intensify the experience, much of the gathering, between teaching sessions and devotional practices, will be held in silence.

The Céile Dé Path exists for people who desire deep involvement in a spiritual life that is rooted in Christ consciousness, the Land, and the Celtic Tradition. It is for people who wish to

dedicate themselves to inner transformation through a disciplined esoteric and devotional path opening to mystical union. Those who understand that a spiritual life is not about having “beliefs” or “dogma”; rather, it is about moving beyond the boundaries of conditioned thinking toward that infinite consciousness called Imbas Forasnai - The Great Knowledge that Illuminates.

The Retreat is limited to 30 people.
